ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE REOPENING OF THE COLLEGE ON 17TH OCTOBER 2020

Management and Staff of BAC would like to welcome back the finalist students from the Covid-19 lockdown and to wish them successful continuation with their academic programmes.

As per the Presidential Address of 20th September to reopen training institutions to finalist students and as guided by the MOES, the College will receive the said category of students on 17th October 2020.

For purposes of ensuring a smooth and successful reopening of the College and preventing the spread of the COVID-19 pandemic, BAC management calls on all students, parents and other stakeholders to take note of and comply with the following guidelines:

EXPECTED GROUP OF STUDENTS

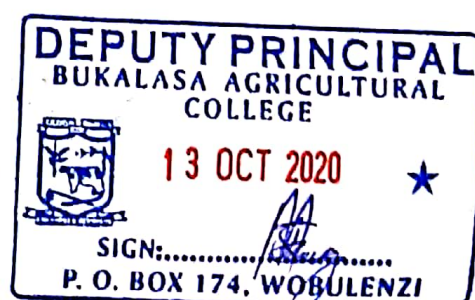
- i) All 2nd Year Diploma Students
- ii) All 2nd Year Certificate Students

RECEIVING OF STUDENTS

- i) Students will be received starting on 17th October 2020 and will undergo the registration process. Therefore, students must carry with them all requirements for registration.
- ii) The registration process will start on Saturday 17th October and continue up to Sunday 18th October 2020.
- iii) All students must clear with all the necessary offices and get clearance before they can access college services and facilities.

PAYMENT OF TUITION

- i) Some students had paid tuition at the start of the semester in March, 2020. All fees paid before lockdown is carried forward. All students who paid full fees last semester need not pay again but those with fees balances must pay to completion.



- ii) However, College Fees Policy still requires that all students pay 60% of the tuition initially as a requirement for clearance
- iii) Payments should be made in Uganda Shillings through Centenary Bank on Account No: 3510021721. Payment instructions include the Student's name and Registration Number.

RESIDENCE STATUS

Student residence status remain as it was before lockdown.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES

- i) Semester will run from 17th October through to late December
- ii) In light of the SOPs given by the Ministry of Health, new classroom space has been created and labelled for each programme

COVID-19 PREVENTION COMPLIANCE

- i) In order to prevent the spread of the Covid-19 pandemic, a college COVID-19 task force has been constituted to ensure SOPs prescribed for training institutions are implemented and adhered to.
- ii) The college COVID-19 task force will generate the BAC protocols to which all students, staff and visitors shall comply
- iii) Students must carry with them at least 2 reusable face masks and advised to carry a personal hand sanitizer (1 litre).
- iv) A COVID-19 sensitization workshop for students will be held on 20th October 2020
